

# MAZDA CONNECT WITH GOOGLE BUILT-IN

Mazda Connect with Google built-in lets you access Google Assistant for hands-free help, Google Maps for built-in navigation, and Google Play to download apps and more.

## DRIVER PROFILE SETUP

Follow these quick steps to unlock the full experience.

### CREATE A GOOGLE ACCOUNT

- Connecting a Google Account to your User Profile lets you access your saved places in Google Maps, download and install apps on Google Play, and more
- Go to [Accounts.Google.com](https://Accounts.Google.com) on your mobile device
- Follow the steps to create an account

### MAKE SURE YOU'RE CONNECTED

- Confirm that your vehicle is enrolled in Mazda Connected Services using your MyMazda App; you can learn more about Mazda Connected Services [here](#)
- All new Mazda vehicles come with a 1-year complimentary trial of Mazda Connected Services, which includes connectivity with Google built-in
- You can also tether your vehicle to a Wi-Fi connection for connectivity

### SET UP A DRIVER PROFILE

It's best to have your Google Account password and smartphone handy before you begin:

1. To create your first Driver Profile, start the vehicle
2. Select your language and then select **"Set Up Profile"**
3. If Mazda Connected Services is not enabled, scan the QR code to set it up
4. Enter a name for the profile
5. Scroll down the list of Google services, make selections, and then tap **"Accept"**
6. Tap **"Set up Assistant and apps"**
7. Use your smartphone to scan the QR code, or sign in on the screen
8. On phone screen, log into account (if using QR code)
9. Your Google Account is now added to the profile

To add additional Driver Profiles (select models only):

1. Tap the Profile icon on the top right of the touchscreen
2. Select **"Profile & Account Settings"**
3. Select **"+ Add a profile"**
4. Repeat steps show above for first Driver Profile setup

## GOOGLE ASSISTANT



Google Assistant lets you control many vehicles features using just your voice. This can be activated multiple ways:


Activate with the Voice Control button:

- On the left side of the steering wheel, press  and release immediately

Activate using your voice:

- Just say "Hey Google"

Activate using the Google Assistant mic icon:

- Tap the  Mic icon on the Navigation bar

Common vehicle function commands:

- "Turn auto climate control on/off"
- "Set the temperature to \_\_ degrees (for the driver/passenger)"
- "Turn the seat heater/ventilation on/off for the driver/passenger"

Common audio commands:

- "Turn up/down the volume"
- "Set the volume to \_\_%"
- "Tune to \_\_ AM/FM/on SiriusXM"

Common navigation commands:

- "Go to the nearest (location category/brand/location name)"
- "Take me (home/work)"
- "Mute guidance"

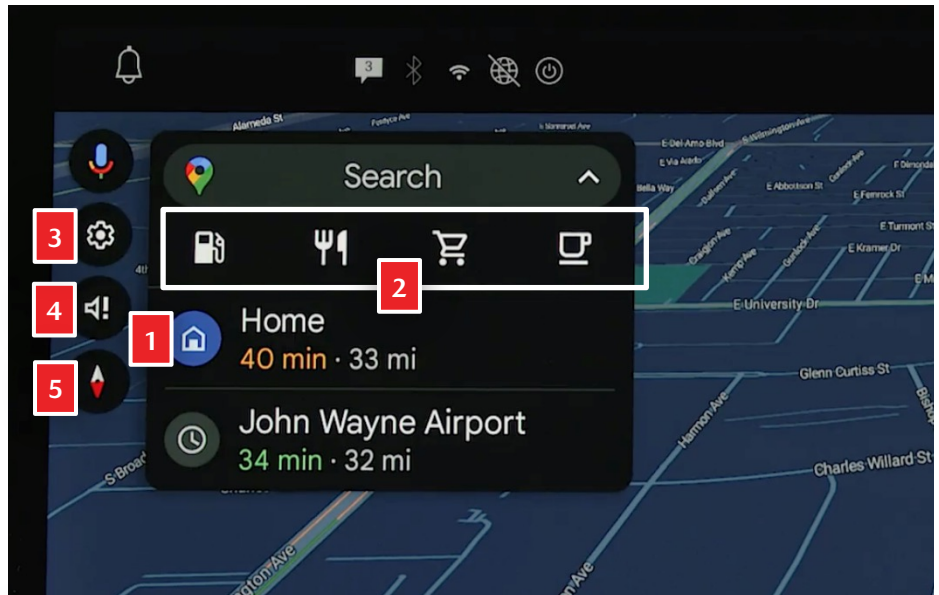
## GOOGLE MAPS

Open using the center display:

- Tap the Map icon  on the Navigation bar
- If you have the Google Maps Navigation Widget shown, tap the widget for full screen Google Maps

Open using your voice:

- Press the Voice Control button  on the left side of the steering wheel, the Google Assistant microphone icon  on the touchscreen, or say "Hey Google," followed by the voice command, "Open Maps"

- 5 Change map orientation

To access Google Play

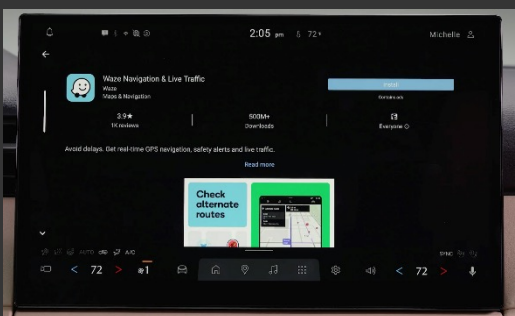
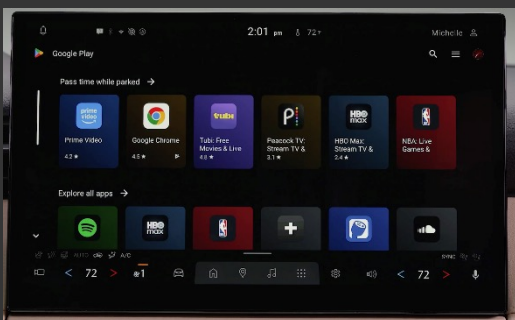
- Tap the Apps icon  on the Navigation bar in the center display

## APPLE CARPLAY® AND ANDROID AUTO™

With wireless Apple CarPlay® and Android Auto™ compatibility, you can connect your iPhone or Android™ smartphone to access your favorite apps for navigation, media, messaging, gaming, and more.

For a first-time connection, it is best to connect your phone to the vehicle using a wired connection:

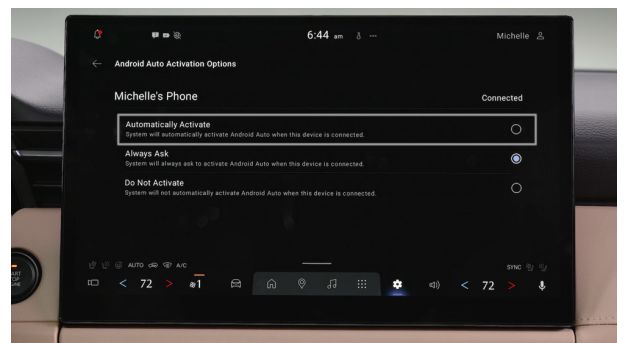
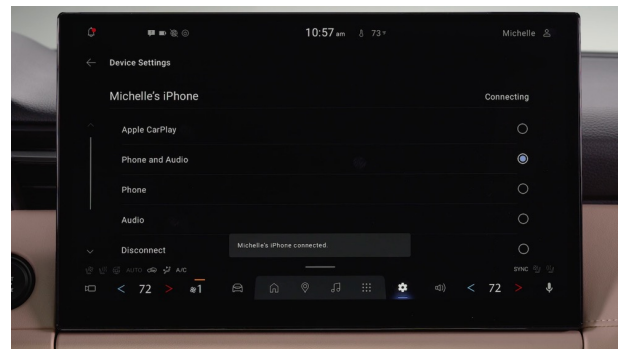
1. Plug the USB into the USB port closest to the driver's seat and connect it to your phone
2. Start the vehicle
3. Check for and grant required permission requests that may appear on both the touchscreen and your phone
4. If asked, enable wireless connectivity on your phone (select Mazda models only)
5. Your phone is now connected

Optional—Auto Connect:

1. On the touchscreen, select **"Settings"** → **"Bluetooth & Phone Connectivity"** → **"Your Phone"**
2. On the touchscreen, select **"Apple CarPlay"** or **"Android Auto Activation Options"** → **"Automatically Activate"**

Delete phone (if needed):

1. On the touchscreen, select **"Settings"** → **"Bluetooth & Phone Connectivity"** → **"Your Phone"**
2. On the touchscreen, select **"Delete Paired Device"**
