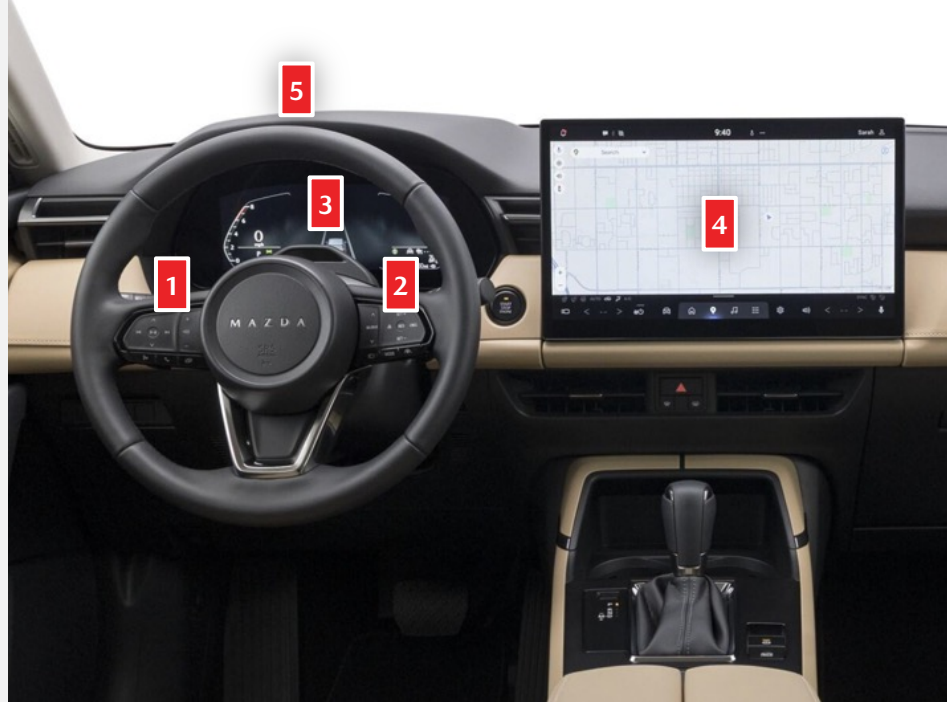


# MAZDA CONNECT TECHNOLOGY OVERVIEW

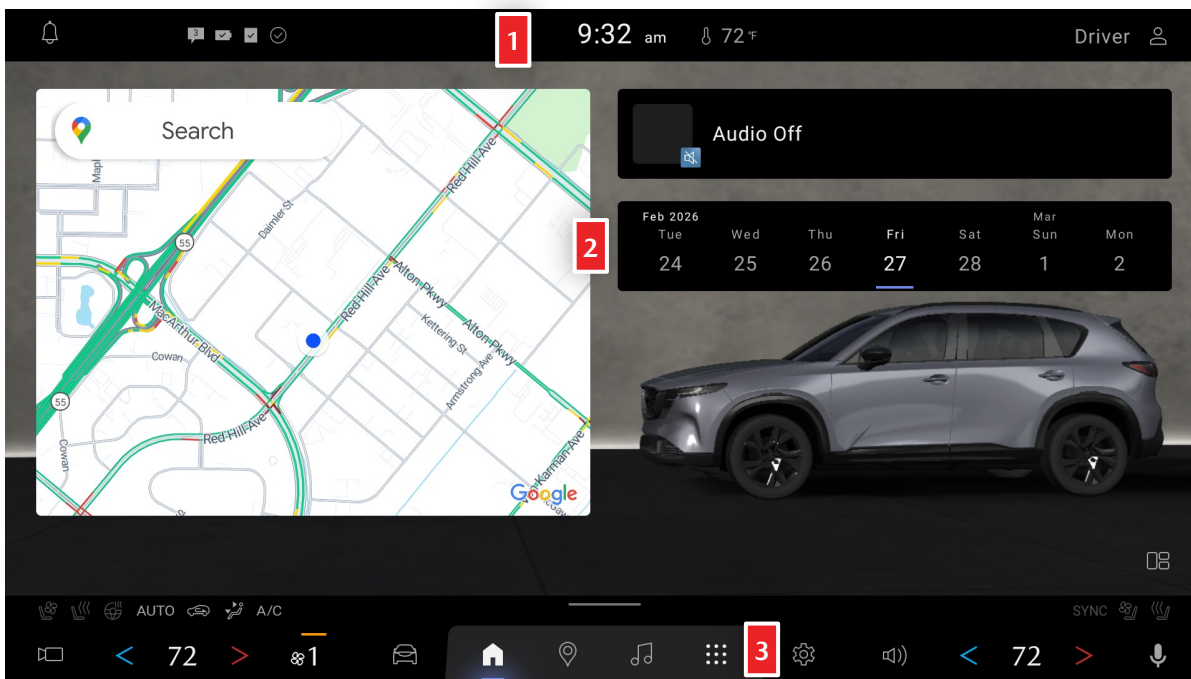
The new Mazda Connect with Google built-in provides its driver with effortless control of the vehicle with minimal distraction.

## OVERVIEW: A CABIN BUILT AROUND THE DRIVER

- 1** Entertainment, phone, and voice assistant controls
- 2** Vehicle controls: Mi-Drive, Mazda Radar Cruise Control and, if equipped, 360° View Monitor, and Cruising & Traffic Support
- 3** Instrument cluster
- 4** Center display
- 5** Active Driving Display (if equipped)



## OVERVIEW: CENTER DISPLAY



- 1 STATUS BAR**  
Vehicle notifications, connection and communication status, time, outside temperature, and user profile
- 2 WIDGET AREA**  
Main interface for the system
- 3 NAVIGATION BAR**  
One-touch access to controls for climate, vehicle settings, maps, apps, camera display, and audio system








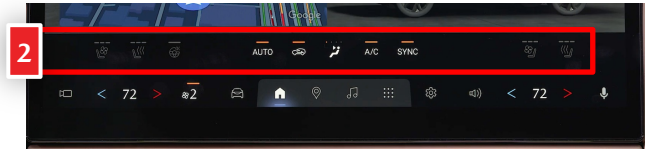



ADJUSTING CLIMATE CONTROL

Using the center display:

- Tap  icon to turn on/off system or adjust fan speed
- Tap blue or red arrows  to change temperature and bring up the temperature slider bar; you can also slide along the temperature bar or tap the bar to adjust the temperature
- Tap the status icons above the temperature controls  to reveal a small climate control screen 
- Swipe up to increase the size of the climate control screen 



Using voice commands:

- Press the voice control button  on the steering wheel, the Google Assistant  icon on the center display or say "Hey Google"
- Speak your command, which could include:
  - "Set the fan speed to 1-7"
  - "Turn up/down the temperature (for the driver/passenger)"
  - "Turn the defroster on/off"
  - "Turn on/off temperature synchronization"
  - "Turn max A/C on/off"
- "Set the temperature to \_\_\_ degrees (for the driver/passenger)"
- "Turn fans on/off"
- "Turn A/C on/off"
- "Turn auto climate control on"

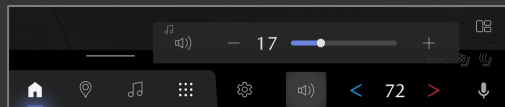

ADJUSTING VOLUME

Using the center display:



- Go to the Navigation bar and tap the speaker icon to bring up the volume slider bar; you can tap + or -, tap along the bar, or slide the bar to raise or lower volume
- Tap the speaker icon on the bar to mute or unmute



Using the steering-wheel-mounted controls:

- Go to the left side of the steering wheel
- Press + or - to raise or lower volume
- Press  to mute/unmute or pause/play media

Using voice:

- Press the voice control button  on the left side of the steering wheel, the Google Assistant icon  on the center display or say "Hey Google"
- Speak your command, which could include:
  - "Turn up/down the volume"
  - "Set the volume to \_\_\_%"








## ADJUSTING AUDIO CONTROLS


Using the steering-wheel-mounted controls:

- Press the  or  buttons on the steering wheel to bring up the Source List
- Tap  or  until the desired source is highlighted and the source will begin playing
- Tap  or  to change the station, channel, or track for the selected source



Using the center display:

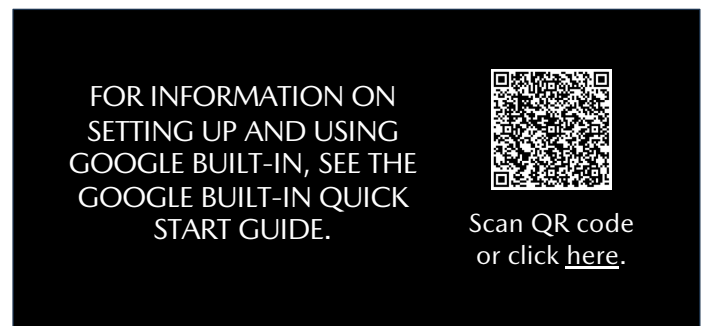
- Tap the  icon to bring up the Now Playing Screen
- Tap the  icon again to show all available audio sources
- Tap to select the desired source

OR




- Tap the  icon
- All available apps will show, with the four most recently used audio sources appearing at the top
- Tap to select the desired source

Using voice commands:

- Quickly press the voice control button  on the steering wheel, the Google Assistant icon  on the center display or say "Hey Google"
- Speak your command, which could include:
  - "Pause/Resume/Skip/Previous song"
  - "Tune to \_\_. (frequency/station name) AM/FM"
  - "Play music (song name/artist/genre/album) from YouTube Music"
  - "Play music (song name/artist/genre/album) from Spotify"
  - "Play (station name or number) on SiriusXM"



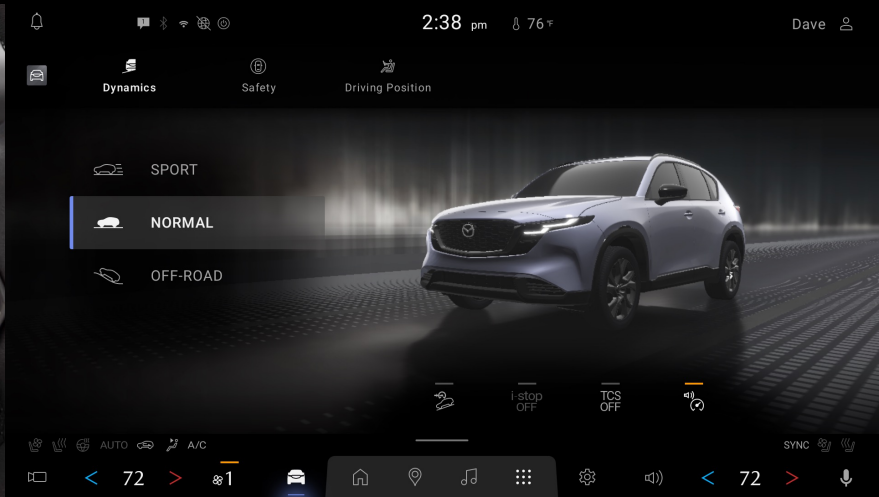
## SAVING OR ADJUSTING DRIVING POSITION MEMORY

- Go to the Navigation bar
- Tap the  Vehicle Settings icon
- Tap "Driving Position"  near the top to display the "Driving Position" page
- Adjust the driver's seat, mirrors, and Active Driving Display to your preferred setting
- Tap the  icon next to the position that you'd like to save and then select "Save"
- Once the two driving positions are saved, return to this screen to switch between Driving Position 1 and Driving Position 2
- Saved driving positions can also be linked to specific key fobs (see the video linked below to learn how)
- For information on the available Driver Personalization System, see the owner's manual

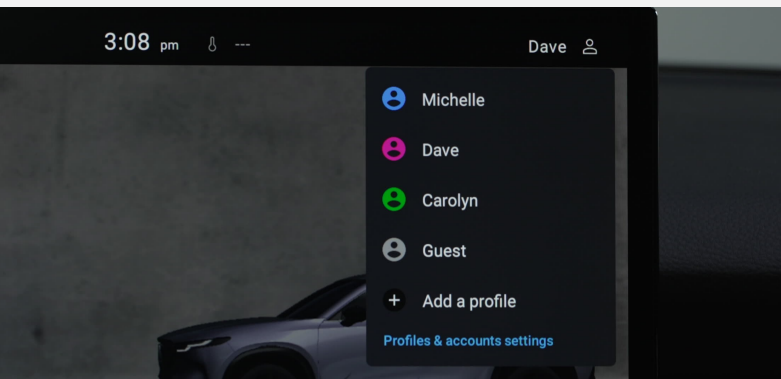
SELECTING MI-DRIVE MODE

Using the steering-wheel-mounted controls:

- Use the or buttons on the right side of the steering wheel to display the available drive modes
- Tap or until the desired Drive Mode is highlighted to select it

Using the center display:

- Go to the Navigation bar
- Tap the Vehicle Settings icon
- Select the desired Drive Mode



CHANGING DRIVER PROFILE (SELECT MODELS)

Using the center display:

- Go to the Navigation bar while in PARK
- Tap the icon
- Select the desired Driver Profile

ADJUSTING i-STOP

The i-Stop feature on your Mazda can automatically stop and restart the engine to improve fuel economy while reducing idling noise and exhaust emissions. You can stop the operation temporarily, if needed:

- Go to the Navigation bar
- Tap the Vehicle Settings icon
- Tap i-Stop Off
- i-Stop will remain off until the next time the vehicle is restarted

ADJUSTING i-ACTIVSENSE® FEATURES

i-ACTIVSENSE® safety and convenience features are designed to help support the driver in everyday driving situations. They can be turned off/on or adjusted using the center display screen:




- Go to the Navigation bar
- Tap the  Vehicle Settings icon
- Tap "Safety"  near the top to display the "Safety" page
- Certain i-ACTIVSENSE® features will appear; tap on each to turn them on or off
- To adjust these and other i-ACTIVSENSE® features, tap the  Settings icon at the top right of the Safety page
- You can also tap the i-ACTIVSENSE® mute button—it is located on the lower left dash panel

ADJUST PARKING SENSORS

The parking sensors on your Mazda help assist driver safety at low speeds by detecting obstructions around the vehicle and alerting the driver. The sensors should remain on whenever possible. However, there are times when it may be best to temporarily turn them off to avoid false alerts:

- Go to the Navigation bar
- Tap the  Vehicle Settings icon
- Tap the  icon
- Parking sensors will remain off until they are turned back on by pressing the  icon
